Trinity strongly believes in the UN 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. The parish is currently working to address the sixth UN goal by creating a clean water source for the village of Chamhawi, Tanzania. The Trinity Episcopal Church of Canton Scholarship is available to all Canton high school student seniors who plan to enroll at an accredited university or college or plan to attend a trade school. The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, adopted by all United Nations Member States in 2015, provides a shared blueprint for peace and prosperity for people and the planet, now and into the future. At its heart are the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), which are an urgent call for action by all countries - developed and developing - in a global partnership. They recognize that ending poverty and other deprivations must go hand-in-hand with strategies that improve health and education, reduce inequality, and spur economic growth – all while tackling climate change and working to preserve our oceans and forests.

Scholarship Application Details:

Candidate must submit an essay, 500-word minimum length, typed and submitted on one of three UN Sustainable Development Goals: Sustainable Cities and Communities (#11), Climate Action (#13), or Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions (#16). Candidates should express why they chose this goal, their understanding of its importance to the world and their vision of how to impact change to achieve it in some way.

- Essay should place some emphasis on the duties and obligations of citizens of the world in response to the UN issue.
- Please also attach a short paragraph explaining, "Why you are a good candidate for this scholarship"
- Applicants should also enclose one letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, mentor, faith leader or neighbor who can comment on your work ethic and overall character.
- Applicants may apply to this scholarship regardless of the current location of their high school, so long as they are a resident of Canton, MA.
- Applicants may apply to this scholarship so long as they are pursuing higher education college, vocational school, or technical school, or other educational program.
